### **ROAD ADVISORY**

Paulding County Sheriff Jason K. Landers has issued a Level 2 Road Advisory for Paulding County. This Level 2 Road Advisory means that roadways are hazardous with blowing and drifting snow and most of the roadways could be icy. Only those individuals who feel it is necessary to travel should be on the roadways. Sheriff Landers urges people to use caution and common sense in deciding if travel is really necessary. Level 2 does not close the roadways to travel, but it is an advisory against unnecessary travel.

“At this time all roadways here are slick but passable. As the winds pick up, road crews are seeing some drifting. We will work together throughout the day, evening and nighttime to monitor the roadways. Authorities will reassess this road advisory late this evening and again about 5:00 a.m.,” said Sheriff Landers.

Due to road and weather conditions, Sheriff Landers urges anyone driving to leave early, allowing plenty of extra time to arrive at your destination.

While the road conditions may look adequate in the villages and wind protected areas, they are more hazardous out in the county.
